Patient Assistance Program Improvements!



The Conquer MG Patient Assistance Program helps MG patients living in Illinois, Indiana, and now Wisconsin who struggle with the high cost of medical care. The program covers the cost of medical treatment and medication up to \$1,000 per year per person. Funding is still available for 2016.

Recent improvements:

- Eligibility has been expanded to Wisconsin residents, as well as MG patients who live in Illinois or Indiana.
- Covered expenses now include durable medical equipment.
